**CIRCULAR NO. 51.**

To

All The I.T.O. (Railways).

All Stations of Police.

It has come to the notice of Government that Station House Officers some time refuse to record the first information in cognizable offences on flimsy grounds and if they record it, they do not do it promptly and detain the informants for a number of hours in the P.S.

2. Section 164 Cr.P.C. binds every officer-in-charge of a Police Station to reduce in writing every information relating to the commission of a cognizable offence even if given to him orally by the complainant himself or by one on his behalf.

3. Rule 285 (x) of the Rajas than Police Regulations also clearly provides that the I.I.R. should be drawn at once.

4. It is, therefore, ordered that all District Superintendents of Police should instruct their Station House Officers accordingly and direct them to strictly adhere to these instructions.

5. The Circle Officers and Inspectors while visiting Police Stations should ensure that the instructions are fully complied with and not ignored by the Station House Officers.
