From the 1st May 1957, all D.I.s.G.P. should please submit monthly statements to the P.H.Q. ~~stating~~ therein the departmental enquiries which ~~were~~ ^{are} pending with them ~~at~~ ^{on} the beginning of the month. Every pending D.E. should be mentioned in the statements with the following details :-

- (a) Name and No. of the defaulter with his District.
 - (b) ~~charges framed against the defaulter~~
 - (c) Date of receipt of the departmental enquiry ~~having~~ in the D.I.s.G.P's office ~~or date of~~
 - (d) ~~starting the D.E. if the D.G. is himself holding it.~~
 - (e) Reasons ~~why~~ ^{above} the D.E. is pending, for more than 2 months.
2. The statements sent on the 1st of every month ~~should~~ [^] contain all ~~cases~~ ^{pending} cases in the D.I.s.G.P's office even if they are mentioned or repeated in the previous statements. They ~~should~~ [^] be continued to be shown until they are disposed of.
3. The ~~above~~ statements should be received in the P.H.Q. by the 7th of every month. The first statement should come by the 7th May 1957.
