2. The examination shall carry 150 marks. Details of the syllabi of examination shall be as given in appendix 'A'. There shall be an additional paper in Hindi of 50 marks for adjudging proficiency of ~~the~~ those candidates who did not pass their High School/Higher Secondary Examination in Hindi.

3. The Committee nominated by the I.G. of Police shall adopt the criteria for selection as ~~prescribed in~~ provided in Rules 19(4) & 20(1) of the Rajasthan Police Sub-Ordinate Service Rules, 1966.
