STANDING ORDER No. 18

Subject: INSPECTIONS.

In supercession of this office order No.8(1)Police-(A)-Sec-69/757 dated 24-5-1969 on the subject, enclosed please find a revised statement showing the scale of minimum Inspections - prescribed for various officers of the Department. The scale laid down should be strictly enforced.

- 2. The object of inspection is not a statistical test nor to criticise and find fault with subordinates but to suggest and or take measures for bringing about improvements in the Police working and administration. It is also one of the best methods by which senior officers, besides knowing the State of Crime, Standard of Investigation, preventive work etc. can also closely know their subordinates and their personal difficulties.
- 3. Routine and superficial inspections do not serve any useful purpose and shall be avoided. The inspections should be so planned as to complete the same within first ten months of the year leaving the last two for any unforeseen and urgent work. Only through inspections bring efficiency.
- These instructions may give a thinking that inspection work has increased. But without these, effective supervision and control over one's own office and subordinate offices is considerably diminished. In addition these inspections also afford an opportunity to the officers to know the real state of affairs in their Districts/ Units. According to the revised schedule of inspections, some of the Superintendents of Police have to inspect all of their Police Stations including Out Posts while others have to conduct formal detailed and informal brief inspections in the ratio of 50: 50. This should be possible if the inspections and are planned and spaced according to the Schedule. As a reule an Out Post under a Police Station should be inspected along with the Police Station. During rainy season, inspection of those units which do not require out door work i.e., offices of C.Os., Hqrs., P.Ss., M.O.B. D S B etc. may be taken up. The Superintendents of Police may undertake inspection of offices in different stages i.e., some of the branches 30 could be inspected in one quarter and the remaining in the next quarter.

- 5. In certain cases two types of inspections viz, formal and informal have been envisaged. In this regard it is clarified that the P.Ss. which have been formally inspected in one year need not be inspected in detail next year. Similarly, the Police Stations inspected informally in one year must be inspected in detail the next year.
- 6. The informal inspections should be in respect of disposal of crime, training and knowledge of men, relations with Public, buildings and other important matters. While conducting inspections, the Ss.P. / Addl.Ss.P. / C.Os. should also test the knowledge and ability of the H.Cs. and Constables to assess their performance standard and record the same in their inspection note.
- 7. Detailed instructions about the method of inspections of various units have already been issued per this office $\frac{N_{\bullet}}{5.8}(1)$ Police-(A)Sec/69/1926-2000 dated 9-10-1969.
