STANDING ORDER NO. 1 /77

Subject: - Powers under the Rajasthan Police Subordinate Service Rules 1974.

-oOo-

Consequent to the creation of the post of Additional Inspector General of Police, Training, the following powers under the above rules shall henceforth be exercised by the Addl. I.G. of Police, Training :

DIRECT RECRUITMENT

Rule 13(2)(v) :

The power of relaxation in physical fitness in case of Constables only (excluding A.C.D. which powers shall be exercised by the Addl. Inspector-General of Police, A.C.D. ) shall be ~~exercised~~ exercised strictly in accordance with the provisions of the rule.

Rule 34 (2), (3) and (4) -

Syllabi, training and examination thereto by regularly constituted boards of Directly recruited Constables and Sub-Inspectors.

PROMOTION

Rule 24 (3)

Constitution of Selection Boards mentioned in sub-rule (b) (excluding A.C.D.) and (e) only. The Selection Boards in (a) & (b) in respect of A.C.D. will be constituted by Addl. I.G.P. A.C.D.

Rule -27 - Promotion Cadre Courses

- (1) Arrangement for training courses for the candidates duly selected by various boards constituted under rule 24(3).
- (2) Syllabi and duration of courses in respect of the candidates selected by various boards.
- (3) Constitution of various boards for conducting the examination of the candidates under-going the Promotion Cadre Courses.

NOTE :- (1) Syllabi and duration of the P.C.C. for promotion to the post of Inspectors/Commanders as well as constitution of for final examination on completion of course shall be got approved by the

- (2) Syllabi, duration of courses and constitution of Boards for examination in respect of candidates mentioned at Rule 24(3)-(e) and (f) will be in consultation with the Director, State Police Wireless.

APPROVAL OF TRAINING RESULTS -

Final results of the directly recruited Sub-Inspectors, Platoon Commanders, departmentally promoted S.Is., P.Co., Inspectors and Company Commanders as well as of Wireless Inspectors/Supervisors/S.Is. shall be placed before the I.G.P. for approval.

PASSING OUT PARADES-

(A) - Direct Recruitment.

Passing-out Parades of :-

- (i). Constables shall be arranged by the Addl. I.G.P. Training from time to time in consultation with the I.G.P.
- (ii). Sub-Inspectors shall be arranged by the Addl. I.G. of Police Training with the approval of the I.G.P.

(B). - Promotion Cadre Courses -

If the Addl. I.G.P. feels to have passing out parades of P.C.Co. also, he should arrange the same but in respect of Sub-Inspectors and above, he shall do so with the prior approval of the I.G.P.

All other matters pertaining to training not covered by this circular shall be submitted to the I.G.P. for orders.

If any doubt arises in respect of the use of the powers mentioned above, the matter shall be referred to the I.G. Police.
