Sub:- SYLLABUS FOR QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR PROMOTION TO THE POST OF ASI (CP) AND SI (CP).

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It is in supersession of I.G.P.'s Circular Order No. 6/76 dated 24.4.76 and other orders issued on the subject.

2. As provided for in Rule 26 of the Rajasthan Police Subordinate Service Rules, 1974, the following general instructions are issued in respect of Part-II of the Qualifying Examination :-

3. The break-up of 100 marks allotted for Part-II Record and interview will be as under :-

Marks deducted for various types of Punishments will be as under :-

NOTE :- Out of 30 marks allotted for rewards and punishments, 15 marks each will be earmarked for rewards and punishments respectively. The calculation of marks for rewards will be on the basis of 0 to 15 i.e. marks for each good entry of the reward will be added upto the maximum of 15. For bad entries of punishments, the calculation will be on the basis of 15 to 0 that is if the candidate does not have any punishment on his record, he will get maximum 15 marks. Marks for each bad entry will be deducted from this total of 15. The total marks secured for rewards out of 15 plus the balance marks out of 15 for punishments will be the number of marks the candidate will secure under this head.

Illustration :

- (i) 'A', a candidate has 4 C.Cs. with cash reward given by DIG and 8 C.Cs. with cash given by S.P. Total marks for these good entries will be 16 but the same will be restricted to maximum allotted for rewards i.e. 15. This candidate 'A' has punishments of stoppage of two grade increments without future effect and 4 censures. Marks for these bad entries will be 7. This number will be deducted from the marks allotted for punishment i.e. 15 and the balance will come to

This balance under punishment i.e. 6 marks will be added to 15 marks secured for rewards. Thus net marks secured for rewards and punishment will be 15 plus 6 i.e. 23 ( out of 30 ).

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- (ii). Candidate 'B' has no reward and no punishment on record. He will secure NIL marks under head reward. But since he has no punishment on record, he will get all the 15 marks without any deduction under head punishment. Thus his marks secured under head Rewards and Punishments will be 15 out of a total of 30.

II- Annual remarks in ACRs./APARs. .. 30 Marks  
(for last five years).

The Board, after over all assessment of an ACR/APAR Report, will classify the remarks for each year, in one of the following categories and assign marks accordingly :-

B. Interview :- .. 40 Marks

In interviewing candidates, regard shall be had to the following factors :-

- i) intelligence, tact and energy,
  - ii) technical and general knowledge including education, training and general awareness,
  - iii) personality (including turn out, address and behaviour) and character,
  - iv) experience and efficiency,
  - v) physical fitness and capacity to discharge duties of the post to which promotion is to be made including aptitude to undertake extensive tours,
  - vi) practical knowledge of law and procedure, and
  - vii) integrity,
- and marks awarded accordingly.
