An instance has been brought to my notice in which a Radio-Gram has been sent by an S.P. to the Chief Secretary communicating him about a highway dated ty which was committed in his distt. but no copy of this message was endorsed weither to the Home Deptt. of Govt. or to the P.H.Q.

The procedure for sending special reports has been very clearly discussed in this office circular No. 119 of 1953 dated the 30th December, 1953

It has again been repeated in this office No. 8091/8116/CB/GS.

/GS, dated the 24th June, 1954 that when-ever a special report case
occurs in any dist. in which special report is required to be sent to
the Govt. such report should be sent to the Chief Minister with copy
endorsed to the Home Deptt. and P.H.Q. In all these cases only initial
report would be sent by the BSP direct to the Govt. and all progress
and continuation reports will be sent to the P.H.Q. (C.I.D.) by the
Ss.P.

It should always be borne in mind that channel of communications to the Govt. for the police is the Home-Deptt. and as such all reports intended for the Govt. should be addressed to the Home Secy. and in cases in which reports are to be sent to the Chief Minister a copy of the same should invariably be endorsed to the Home Department.

Govt. has also invited attention to the belated reports received from Ss.P. It is high time that officers realise their responsibility and act according to the instructions. Any failure on their part w will hereafter be reported to the Govt.
