Rewards in criminal cases should normally be given after the final decision by the court. The practice of sanctioning rewards immediately after the case is challaned or the work is done should forthwith CAMER cease and the final disposal of the case should always be awaited.

The case of Encounters and Arrests of dacoits etc., however, stand on a different footing and in these cases the rew-ards may be sanctioned as soon as anything is done.

Cases deserving award of the Gallantry Medals should be given priority and citation immediately sent to the D.I.G. C.I.D., within a week of the achievement secured for transmission to the Government. They should always be accompanied by three copies of the photographs of pass-port size of the recommendee along with his integrity contificate in triplicate. This with his integrity certificate in triplicate. This procedure should be strictly followed and in case of doubt the DIG CID may be consulted in the matter.
