Sub: - MESS ALLOWANCE.

References have been received from various Distts. for clarification as to (1) Whether the grant of Mess Allowance is confined to only the armed Police or the Civil Police or both (2) Whether the members of the messes run in the Police Stations & Kotwalis are entitled to the Mess Allowance, and (3) Whether the members of the Police Stations who join the Mess in the Police Lines are entitled to the Mess Allowance. The position in this regard is clarified as under: -

- (1) As per rule 2(1) of the standing orders all lower subordinates, whether they belong to A.P. or C.P., residing in the Police Lines, excepting those who have actually got their families with them, are required to join messes and are entitled to the Mess Allowance.
- (2) In Circular No. IV/87/27/G/2692 dated 23-7-51 it has been clearly laid down that the standing orders are for the management of the messes in the Distt. Police Lines. Those persons who have not joined the messes of the Distt. Police Lines or R.A.C. will not be entitled to the mess allowance.
- (3) As per rule 2 (2) of the standing orders read with para of the Circular those H.Cs. and Constables of Police Stations who join the Police Lines Mess will be entitled to Mess Allowance as the prescribed rate. Members of the Messes run in Police Stations or Kotwalis are not eligible for this allowance.
