By virtue of the powers vested in the Director General of Police, Rajasthan under rule 3(1) of the Rules for the conduct of Departmental Examination of I.P.S. EXAMINATION OF RECORD OF PRACTICAL POLICE WORK & PARTICIPATIVE INTERVIEW :

Max Marks : 100

Examination of record of practical police work and testing knowledge of the Probationers regarding stores, Equipments etc. Messing and Welfare measure activities in Police.

- (1) (a) The account record etc. will specifically pertain to :-  
 (a) Examination of Working Diaries.  
 (b) Examination of record prepared by the Candidates during training.  
 (c) Examination of P.E.s. and D.E.s. conducted by the Candidates.  
 (d) Examination of Investigation Case Files.  
 (e) Examination of inspections carried out.  
 (f) Examination of Crime Digest, methods adopted for Supervision and control by the Brings.  
 (g) Knowledge of Stores and Equipment, Purchase, Indent, issue, Condemnation etc.  
 (h) Knowledge of Messing and Welfare.  
 (i) Organisation of Welfare activities in Jawaon.

Max Marks : 100

Interview shall be conducted to test knowledge of the Candidates in the following items :-

- (a) Police lines working.
- (b) Organisation of training in P.T., Parades, Musketry and other outdoor demonstrations.
- (c) Ability for organisation and administration.
- (d) Ability for Planning.
- (e) Mental alertness and physical fitness.
- (f) Capacity to undertake hard work, risks and adventure.
- (g) To judge his MOTIVATION AND DEGREE OF INVOLVEMENT in Police work.
- (h) His capacity/ability to undertake :-
  - (i) Research and (ii) Training of personnel under him.


The minimum pass marks in each paper shall be 50% For passing the examination with proficiency the minimum pass marks shall be 50% subject to obtaining not less than 60% in the aggregate.

- (4) In case of an IPS Probationer, who has already undergone practical training while he was in the State Police Service, he may be exempted from such written test and practical Police working examination as may be decided by the State Govt. on the recommendation of the D.G.P. in each individual Case.

Such candidates will be examined in interview and selected papers only as directed by the State Government and their performance shall be determined as of ordinary pass or of proficiency standard from the papers taken by him.

- (5) The Departmental Examination of IPS and RPS (Probationers) shall be conducted by a Board comprising of the following Police Officers :-

1. Addl.D.G.P./Senior most I.G.P. .... Chairman
2. Director, R.P.A.Jaipur ..... Member
3. Dy.I.G.of Police ..... Member
4. Dy.Director, R.P.A.Jaipur, ..... Member Secretary
