# Syllabus for Band Refresher Course

1. **General** :- Refresher Training Course for Rajasthan Police Band personnel will be conducted at the faculty of Rajasthan Police Band Training School, RPA, Jaipur for a duration of 6 weeks. This training intends to re-familiarize the band personnel with the basic concepts, fundamentals & musical compositions which are used on a daily basis and required for regular band-work.
2. **Aim** :- The aim of this course is to effect a perceptible improvement in the standard & performance of the bands of District Police & RAC Units.
3. **Contents** :- The contents of the course are :-
  - (A) Knowledge of Theory -
    - (i) Elements of music
  - (B) Practical knowledge -
    - (i) Major & Minor scales
    - (ii) Major & Minor common chords
    - (iii) To train Band Commander & Band personnel to perfectly play tunes during Ceremonial Parade & other occasions.
4. **Course Plan** :- The course plan is as under -
  - (A) Capacity - 2 band personnel per district & RAC unit with a maximum 40 members with band commander.
  - (B) Duration- 06 Weeks
  - (c) Total no. of days - 42
  - (D) No. of Sundays & second Saturdays- 07
  - (E) Total no. of working days - 35
  - (F) No. of periods per day - 08
  - (G) Total No. of periods - 280

8. **Test :-** Test will be conducted separately in practical & theoretical subjects combined with band performance.

**(A) Marks :-**

(i) Theory (Written) -	50 marks
(ii) Practical ( Band playing performance) -	100 marks
(iii) Director's Evaluation Marks -	50 marks
<b>Total</b>	<b>200 marks</b>

**(B) Final Test :-**

(1) Final Test will be taken by a Board appointed by the Head of Training Institute (Director R.P.A., Jaipur). This Board shall be constituted with the following officers:

(i) Deputy Director & Principal, RPA/ Supdt. of Police	-	Chairman
(ii) Asstt. Director, RPA/ Addl. S.P.	-	Member
(iii) Inspector/In-charge, RPBTs, RPA	-	Member Secretary & Technical Member

(2) Result of the final examination will be prepared by the Board and sent for approval to the Director R.P.A., Jaipur. The result will be declared after the approved by Director, R.P.A., Jaipur.

(3) Director's Evaluation marks will be accorded on the basis of performance & discipline showcased during training. Evaluation

marks will be based on the performance report submitted by In-charge, Rajasthan Police Band Training School, RPA, Jaipur.

(4) Every trainee must obtain 50% marks in individual papers and 55% as aggregate, (including Director's Evaluation marks, i.e. 50) to pass the examination. If a candidate fails to clear the exam, he/she should compulsorily join the next refresher course.

**9. Administration :-**

**(A)** Documents to be maintained by the Course Director -

(i) Nominal Rolls of the students

**(B)** Documents to be maintained by the trainees -

(i) Fair notes and exercises - 12 stave note books

(ii) Otto Langey Tutor books of their instruments

**(C)** Dress - Normal working dress for both Indoor & Outdoor classes

**(D)** Turn out will be inspected by In-charge Rajasthan Police Band Training School, RPA, Jaipur at least once a week

**(E)** Course Director - Inspector/ Company Commander/ Sub Inspector/ Platoon Commander (Band).

**(F)** Instructors - Head Constable (Band)/Constable (Band) from Central Band of RPA Jaipur. Guest Faculty may be invited as per requirement.

**Note:-** All instructors must know reading, dividing and playing their respective instruments in their own clefs.

**(G)** Type & Quantity of instruments must be followed according to the following table as specifically prescribed for full band & half band.
